**Subject: Search Warrant Served**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the METRICH Task Force, Mansfield Police Department, ASORT, and the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) served a search warrant at 1005 Maumee Ave. in Mansfield, Ohio. The investigation ensued after citizen complaints of suspicious activity. The search warrant was signed by the Honorable Judge Jerry Ault.

Tyron Gray was arrested for 2 counts of trafficking in heroin and incarcerated. METRICH Sgt. Steve Blust commended community members for reaching out to local Law Enforcement, and reporting drug activity in their neighborhoods. This continued effort will make our community a safer place to live.
