Subject: Felonious Assault/Wanted Subject

At approximately 1147 hours this morning, the Mansfield Division of Police responded to the 300 block of Remy Avenue in reference to a shooting incident. While in route, officers were advised that the two vehicles involved had fled the area and that the "shooter" was in a white colored Mercedes truck/van. A short time later, the victims who were in the other vehicle involved in the incident were located and contacted.

During the course of the investigation, it was quickly learned that Josh'shun Deonte Anderson (B/M, 22 YOA) was identified as the person responsible for firing the shots at the other vehicle. The incident was a result of a verbal altercation that had occurred prior to the shooting between Mr. Anderson and persons inside the vehicle. The victim's vehicle was struck by gunfire during the incident but fortunately, none of the four occupants; including two young children, were injured.

A "Felonious Assault" warrant has been issued for Mr. Anderson's arrest in reference to this incident. He was last seen wearing a dark teal t-shirt and black shorts. Josh'shun Anderson is considered armed and dangerous and it is our hope that he turn himself in on the charges.

We are asking that anyone who has information concerning Mr. Anderson's whereabouts to please call Mansfield Dispatch at (419) 522-1234 or 911. Please do not approach Mr. Anderson or put yourself at personal risk.
