## **Subject: \*\*\*\*ADDRESS CORRECTION** **Drug Trafficking/Search Warrant Executed**

On Tuesday June 12th, 2012 the METRICH Drug Task Force, with the assistance of the Shelby Police department, executed a drug search warrant at **26 W. Tucker Avenue** in Shelby. The METRICH Drug Task force received complaints of drug trafficking from that residence. A covert investigation ensued, which resulted in a search warrant being issued by the Honorable Judge Jon Schaefer. Detectives seized drugs, cash, drug paraphernalia, and ammunition from a bedroom in the residence. Warrants have been issued for Salvadore J Lopez II for Drug Trafficking. Further charges are pending.
