Authorizing the acceptance of funding from the Ohio Supreme Court in the amount of eight thousand four hundred ninety-six and 22/100 dollars (\$8,496.22) for the purpose of updating the Municipal Court's remote technology, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That funding from the Ohio Supreme Court in the amount of eight thousand four hundred ninety-six and 22/100 dollars (\$8,496.22), for the purpose of updating the Municipal Court's remote technology, is hereby accepted, and the appropriate officers are authorized to execute any and all documents pertaining to the receipt and use of said funds.

SECTION 2. That the sum of eight thousand four hundred ninety-six and 22/100 dollars (\$8,496.22) be, and the same is hereby, appropriated from the unappropriated Grant Fund (#224) to the Municipal Court Grant (224.03.30) Capital Outlay Classification.





ORDINANCE # _____

Authorizing the Mayor and Safety-Service Director to accept funding from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services under the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant (FY2019) in the amount of thirty-five thousand, one hundred fifty-four and 64/100 dollars (\$35,154.64), and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Subgrant Number 2019-PC-NFS-7809, awarded to the City under the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant Program, will provide funds to defray the costs of forensic science overtime, training, travel, supplies and equipment, with twenty-nine thousand seventeen and 21/100 dollars (\$29,017.21) designated for the opioid drug crisis.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Mansfield, Ohio, to avail itself of the opportunities provided by this program and to participate with complete commitment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety-Service Director be, and they are hereby, authorized to accept funding in the amount of thirty-five thousand, one hundred fifty-four and 64/100 dollars (\$35,154.64) from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services under the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant (FY2019), and to execute all documents pertaining thereto.

SECTION 2. That the sum of thirty-five thousand, one hundred fifty-four and 64/100 dollars (\$35,154.64) of the Grant funds accepted in Section 1 hereof be, and the same is hereby, appropriated from the unappropriated Grant Fund (#224) to the following fund accounts in the amounts shown in the following schedule:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:




BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:




NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, STATE OF OHIO:
